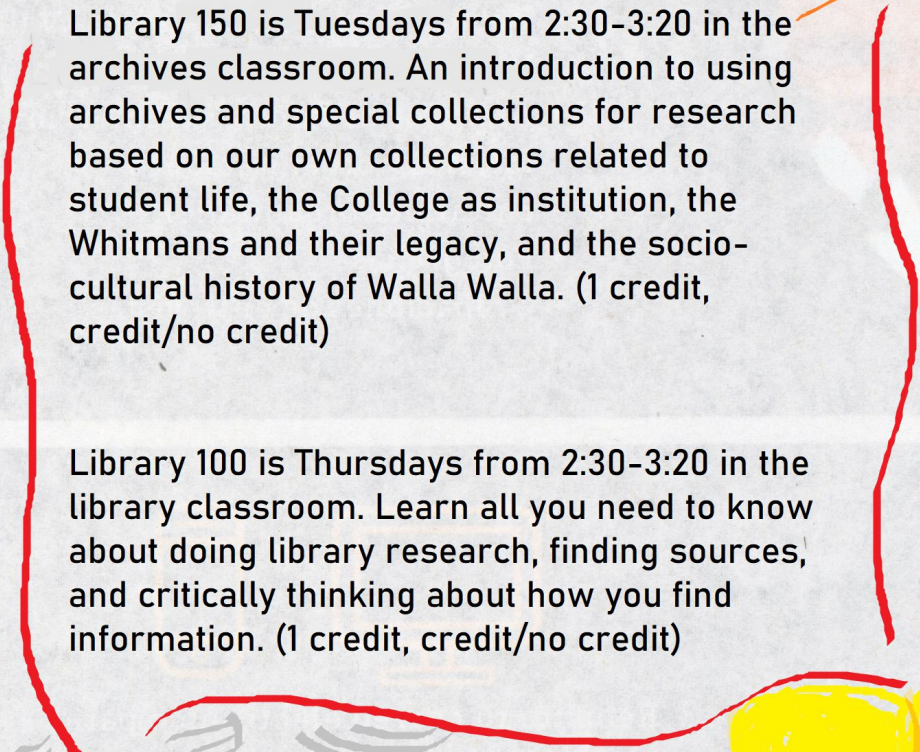
Research Assistance

Librarians are available to help you develop strategies for finding and using resources for your research. Visit the library homepage (library.whitman.edu) for multiple ways to contact us.





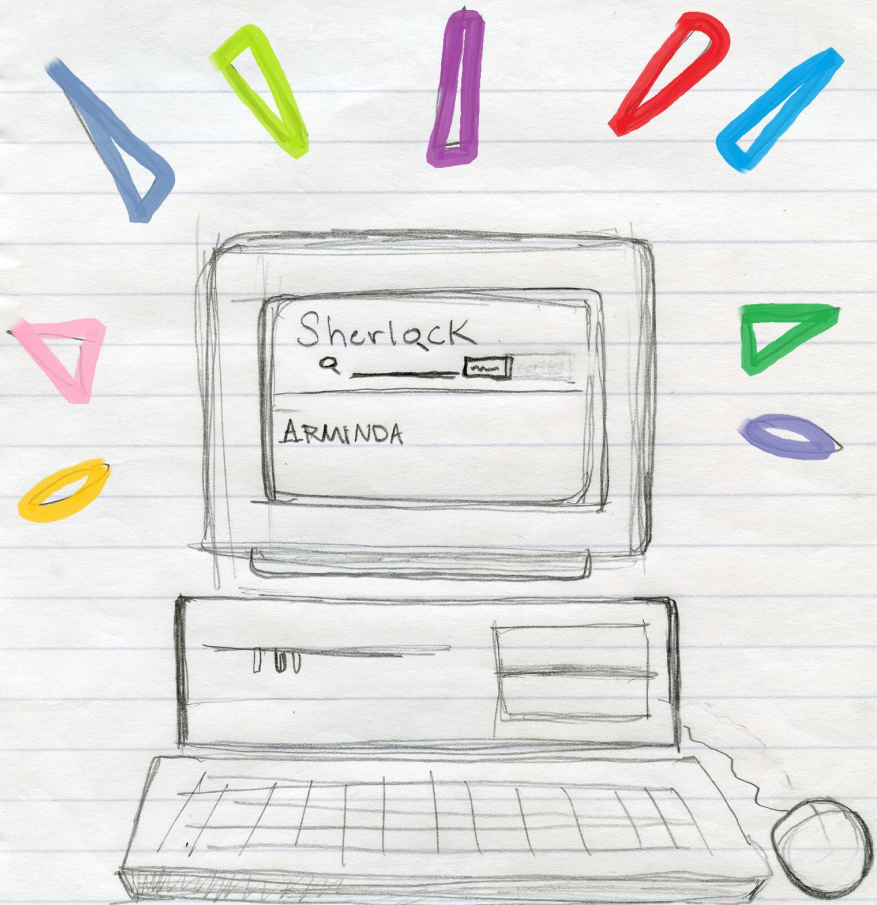
Courses Offered!

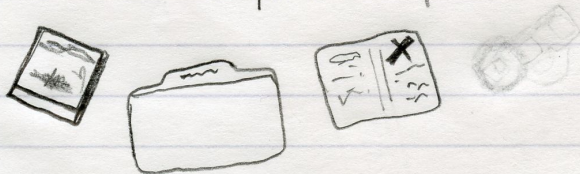

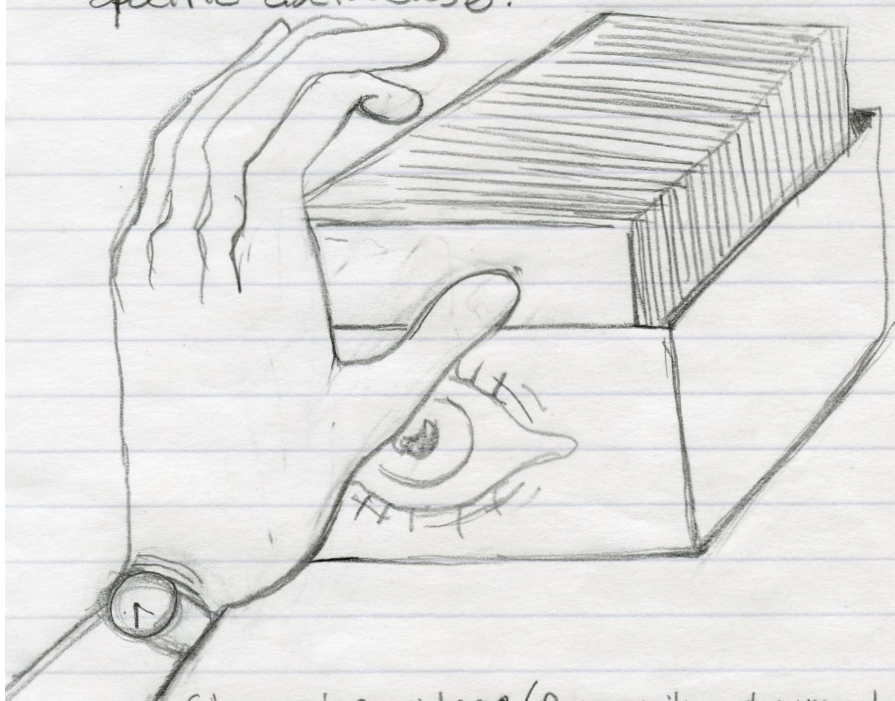

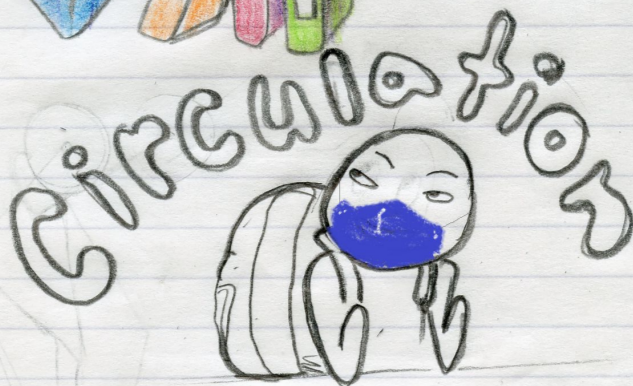
Databases &

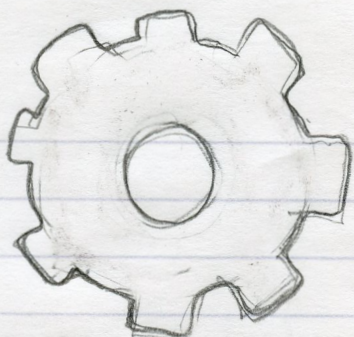

Study Rooms

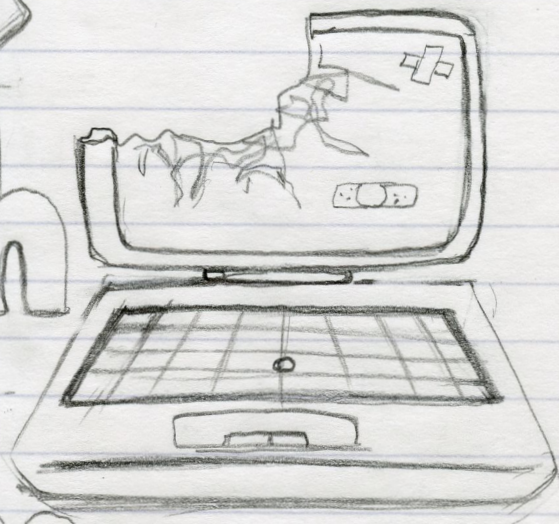
